Infection Prevention & Control (IPC)

- Started in 1974 but IPC activities were conducted by a nursing office
- Several years later an amorphous IPCC constituted to oversee IPC matters.
- August 2011, a gap in care which prompted the start an IPC Unit

- Benchmarking done in Tyggerburg Hospital
- Feb. 2012, wrote to the Board of Management granted autonomy.
- April 2012 –request granted ,staff redeployed

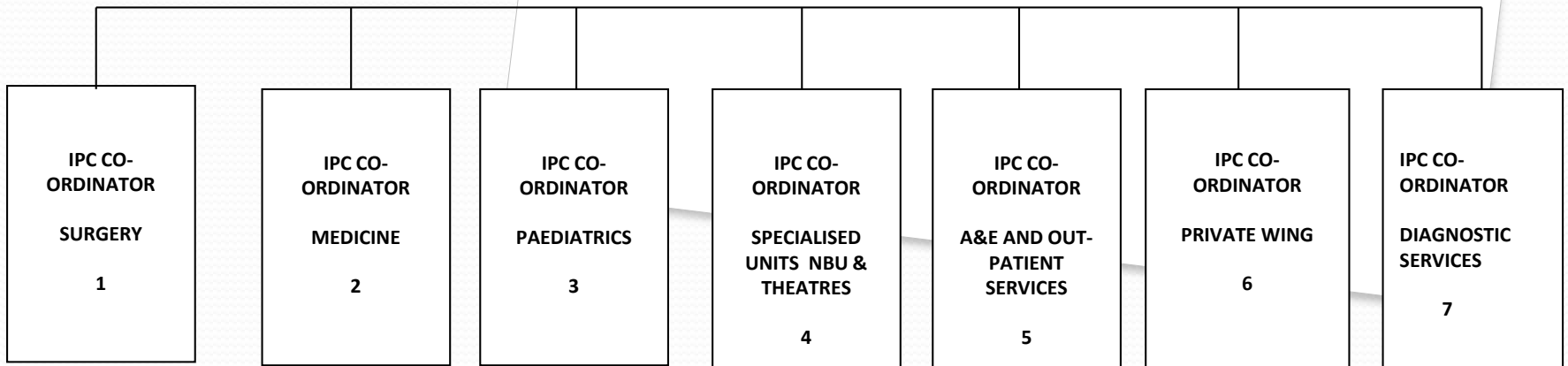
